Welcome to the first edition of the MEOX newsletter - Built For Pressure.

My role in this publication is to provide you with a market overview, an opinion of what I am seeing and hearing whilst meeting with UK OEMs.

Many of you may not know that MEOX is the UK hydraulic hose production arm of Dunlop Hiflex. We are the last remaining direct manufacturer still assembling 'bulk' hydraulic hoses here in the UK.

Following Brexit, our main competition closed their UK production facilities and moved to Eastern Europe. We felt that UK OEMS would suffer, so we took the opportunity to expand our production capabilities and our stock holding.

This has really helped our customers in more recent times. Supply chain issues have led to a forever changing production programme. With our stock and manufacturing, here in the UK, we have been able to react and produce orders on very short lead times, at a time when our competitors quote circa 12 weeks from Europe.

'Green shoring' is a phrase many OEMs are mentioning to me. More of you are looking for reliable UK supply. Not only is this good for safeguarding production, but it's also helping reduce your carbon footprint as companies assembling here in the UK heavily reduce European transport emissions..

I am also seeing a lot of OEMs reducing the quality of their hydraulic hoses in order to counteract increasing costs. Even the top tier manufacturers of hydraulic hose have released products that only meet 400,000 cycles during validation tests. As a result, UK OEMs are experiencing unusually high volumes of warranty claims. This is due to hose covers rubbing together and failing in the field.

Our standard product is still validated to 1m impulse cycles, and in most cases we are still able to offer UK OEMs a big saving by allowing them to come directly to us. By cutting out the middleman we are seeing an average saving of circa 20%.

We have capacity, stock and market-leading support. Feel free to drop me a note anytime and I will personally talk you through our proposition.



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I've been working within the manufacturing industry for the last 15 years. Starting my working life at John Deere, I joined MEOX 7 years ago as Head of Technical. With my Team, we've been building and refining tailor-made hydraulic solutions for major OEMs across the UK using our market-leading Dunlop Hiflex hydraulic product range.

The journey of our Dunlop Hiflex hoses started in Scotland in 1887 and are today used and revered globally.

The First Hoses

Dunlop Hiflex has always been at the forefront of market innovation. From the Early days of John Boyd Dunlop.

John Dunlop's idea about air-filled rubber hoses was the beginning of an industrial manufacturing of air-filled tires and, later, the development of hydraulic and industrial hoses. Dunlop Hiflex, are specialists in hoses for high and low pressure and through our unique position with manufacturing in our own factories, we are leading the development of the next generation of top-quality hoses. But we still carry the name that originated from a Scot and bike with pride.

Hydraulic Hoses of Today

In a world with ever-increasing flow rates, higher working pressures and complex installations, the need for hydraulic spiral hoses to perform with smaller bend radii and extreme flexibility is forever increasing. Dunlop Hiflex has a long history of technical innovation, culminating in the range of the new PowerflexBio Extra high-performance spiral hoses.

These new spiral hoses were born from the need to exceed the ever-more demanding demands of modern hydraulic systems, as flow rates have increased so too have hose bore sizes, making installations tighter and putting greater strain on traditional spiral hoses.

Subjecting a hose to a bend radius smaller than the recommended minimum, places excessive stress on the reinforcement. This reduces the ability to withstand pressure, in particular, bending immediately behind the ferrule can cause undue strain on the hose reinforcement, this is a common cause of failure.

PowerflexBio Extra has improved the minimum bend radius and when coupled with the new improved interlock range of hose fittings the minimum behind the ferrule bend distance can be reduced.

When coupled with the new H17 interlock fittings the Powerflex Bio extra offers extreme and unrivalled flexibility, bend radii are up to 60% less than ISO 18752 specifications.

What does this mean for you, the customer?

Ease of fitment, with less force required to bend the hoses into position installation, is quicker and safer.

Long service life, all the PowerflexBio Extra range Exceeds impulse test performances according to ISO 18752 and features a Hi-Tuff cover for top abrasion & ozone resistance.



Compatibility, the PowerflexBio Extra range is fully compatible with Bio hydraulic oil.

Performance and Homologation, Performance according to ISO 18752 Grade C and Type C. full range of type approvals and homologations.


